COURSE CHANGES APPROVED

Counselor Education

CED 745, Assessment, Treatment, and Case Management in Addictions

Change title to: Assessment, Treatment, and Case Management in Addictions and Mental Health

Change description to: Provides theoretical framework for assessing and treating individuals with addiction and mental health issues and the practical application of managing clients cases from initial treatment stages through discharge and aftercare.

CED 755, Planning, Management, and Evaluation of Addictions Programs

Change title to: Planning, Management, and Evaluation of Addictions and Mental Health Programs

Change description to: Develops skills in applying basic management, planning, and evaluation techniques to addictions and mental health programs. Areas stressed include the relationships between program evaluation, program planning, program effectiveness, and organizational performance.
